WHY ME, IN THREE LINES

- **Your stack is my daily stack.** FastAPI service on PyPI with OAuth and a remote MCP server (polar-flow); TypeScript MCP server with 603 stars and 18.8k installs in 30 days (coolify-mcp); React front end on a two-sided marketplace taken from an unrecoverable codebase to live in 4 months.
- **I ship LLM features that are measured.** Bellwether drafts a daily briefing from 4.7M items with a human approving every issue; evals from real inputs, a cost ceiling designed first.
- **I have run enterprise delivery.** Seven years leading platform engineering at Pfizer: repo-to-production platform for 100+ microservices, deploys from hours to minutes, 99.9% uptime.

- MCP server letting Claude and other agents operate a self-hosted PaaS. v3 shipped with OAuth, a release gate of 37 automated checks plus 8-hour soak tests, and outside contributors landing PRs. 603 stars, 18.8k installs/month (npm, Sep 2026).

- Board-fed research agent drafts a daily briefing from 4.7M ingested items, with human approval in the loop. Since September 2026 the drafting pipeline runs as a LangGraph service: research, write, critic and pro-se-gate nodes with bounded rewrite loops, Postgres checkpoints so a killed run resumes mid-graph, LangSmith traces, approve/reject as a graph interrupt. Runs on a cost-capped model tier because the economics were designed first.

- Concept to live marketplace in 4 months. Stripe Connect card-on-file, payout windows, dispute flows, admin AI briefing, an MCP admin surface so the founders query the business from Claude. Found and fixed a webhook fault that had silently dropped events for months, verified end to end on prod.

2026 · Python (FastAPI) · SDK on PyPI · listed in the MCP registry

- Remote MCP server with OAuth and MCP Apps views, so an agent can read a user's recovery, sleep and training data and act on it.

- Inherited a bloated prototype. 22 tables to 10, 59k lines removed, 0 to 59 tests, full API and mobile app, after agencies had quoted six figures.
